Dear Jonathan,

I am writing to request permission to expend a portion of the funds of MH-11380 (EEG and Human Psychopharmacology) allocated for international travel to permit my participation in the symposium "Electrophysiological Correlates of Behavior" at the XVIIIth International Congress of Psychology in Moscow during the first week in August 1966.

In the renewal request for MH-11380-02, a sum of \$800 was requested and approved for international travel to permit attendance at the German CINP. While I believe attendance at this meeting would be most helpful, I am writing to request approval to participate in the International Congress of Psychology since they have planned a special symposium on quantitative aspects of EEG. The scientific methods for such analyses which have been produced by scientists behind the iron curtain have shown much promise. Some of the material was presented in Vienna and Salzburg and I believe that our research program will be enhanced materially by the opportunity to participate in this symposium and to visit the laboratories of Mme. Bechtereva and Lhivanov.

May we have your approval for the allocation of this sum to permit participation at this meeting? (Incidentally, the expenses will probably be \$300 higher. If it is possible to allocate this amount from another part of the grant award, this would expedite the visits described.)
