Dear Lee:

During the past year, the Foundation has appointed a number of employees from overseas, some of whom have come to the United States on an immigrant visa while others have come as exchange students under P.L. 87-256. We hold exchange student visa P-II-3388. On behalf of a number of scientists, we have filed Form I-140.

Three men have recently been appointed, including Drs. Alexander M. Don, Takumi Ikuta, and J. C. Holden. The first two are on exchange student status, while the third is on immigrant status. It has been brought to my attention that the Federal taxation laws applicable to these men are different than those applicable to permanent residents of the United States. Therefore, I would appreciate your obtaining all the necessary documents from the Internal Revenue Service, reviewing them, and providing the Foundation with a general statement regarding the tax status so that we can be prepared to notify these appointees as well as new appointees of their obligations.

More important, perhaps, is that if there is a discriminatory tax situation, I should like to bring this to the attention of the Foundation so that modifications may, if necessary, be made in the stipends paid such candidates.
