Separately, I have sent you the data collected in the Repoise study using the liquid vehicle. You will find the summaries for each case, the original case data report, laboratory data bound together, and the NIMH data analyses and card output. Dr. Clare and Dr. Simeon have completed a report of their findings and this is now being typed. It will be sent to you for your comments within a week.

I am particularly interested in your comments concerning the laboratory data output. You know that this results from programs written here using the MIP laboratory scale. Since then, we have completed a review of our experiences and improved the data collection form so that the drug data will also appear on the final reports. Copies of these will be sent to you separately. (Since we have used the butaperazine material as our working model, I will take the liberty of sending sample pages from these laboratory reports to the ECDEU investigators. I trust you have no objection.)

Also, I want to thank you for the referral of Dr. Clark. His suggestion that we undertake a study of the long term effects of fenfluramine is a good one and I will explore this further. I will send him a protocol on AHR-1900 this week.
