This past week end I discussed the long acting form of fluphenazine with Dr. Anthony Heusler, who was one of our co-workers here. He recommended that I call Dr. Rizzo, who referred me to you.

Recently, we believed we had found a number of subjects for whom this long acting form of psychotropic drugs might be particularly helpful. We are writing to inquire whether this preparation is available, and if we could have a small supply for our study purposes?
