Dear Helmut,

Our method of EEG analysis is based on an IBM 1800 system, which was put together in 1966. For 1970, it is too expensive and I would not suggest you try to use our methods.

We have programs for period analysis, power spectrum, and amplitude analysis, as well as sleep programs. Different methods are useful for different problems, and I would be glad to advise you if you will describe the problem for which you wish to quantify the EEG.

Separately I am sending you some reprints of our work.

If I have the opportunity to spend some time in Europe, I will surely try to visit Graz-- hopefully to try sailplaning with an expert.
