Dear Mr. Alfano:

Following our discussions I am enclosing the yellow copy of permit #2429, dated May 5, 1969. On May 16, 1969, I returned to the United States from Athens, Greece. I brought with me 250 Grams powdered hashish, which I obtained from Professor C. J. Miras, University of Athens. The material was inspected at Kennedy International Airport and a notation made on the back of the green copy. I had anticipated receiving an additional supply of THC- Δ -9 and kept the permit in my possession. This supply was not sent nor have I received it. Unfortunately, neither my secretary nor I can recall the fate of the green copy. We do not anticipate importing under this certificate any additional supplies.

The material brought in last May, less some that we have already used in our studies, is in our control in the laboratory at 5 East 102nd Street.
