Enclosed is my reply to the population inquiry. In addition to a classification by populations, phase of drug study emphasized, perhaps a classification of special interests and services might be useful, such as the units focussed on clinical toxicology, international collaborative studies, ophthalmology and EKG, and EEG.

Effective this month, Dr. Jovan Simeon has rejoined the staff of the Missouri Institute of Psychiatry and he has been replaced in my programs by Dr. Richard Abrams. Dr. Abrams has been a research fellow for more than 2 years and has focussed on studies of ECT, memory mechanisms and recently the treatment of alcoholism with an alcohol antagonist and schizophrenia with heavy metal chelating agents. I would be pleased if he were placed on the ECDEU mailing lists, at the above address.
