Dear Dr. Serafetinides:

Professor Driver has written to Dr. George A. Ulett, the Director of the Division of Mental Diseases of Missouri, requesting information regarding an opportunity with Dr. Ulett.

Dr. Ulett assumed a new position a year and a half ago as Director of the Division of Mental Diseases of the State of Missouri. At that time he created a new research and training center in St. Louis at the St. Louis State Hospital. This center is described in greater detail in the enclosed description.

I recollect meeting you during my visit last September to Professor Margerison. At that time, I had no idea that you might be interested in coming to the States.

We have established laboratories in electroencephalography, pharmacology, and a research computer center. Dr. Turan Itil joined my staff in March from the University of Erlangen. His interest in EEG and human psychopharmacology coincide with my own, and together we are devoting a major portion of the laboratories' energies to this type of work.

Last winter, Professor Margerison visited us at a time when we were still brand new. I would be pleased to have you discuss our opportunities with him.

If you are interested in joining a unit such as this, I should be grateful for a copy of your curriculum vita, as well as a candid letter regarding your hopes and ambitions in coming to the States.
