I was having lunch with John Knott at the Eastern EEG meeting in New York and he suggested that since I am now in the Midwest that I attend the next meeting of the Central EEG.

Our present program is devoted to a variety of analyses of drug induced changes in the EEG using an IBM 1710 computer. We have had a variety of experiences in programming (period analysis, power spectrum, auto-correlation, random stage), digitizing, and the data analysis. If you believe this society would be interested, I should be prepared to present a progress report on the application of such a computer system to EEG analysis (digital computer analysis of the EEG using an IBM 1710), or, a preliminary report on the effect of pentothal on EEG as quantified in digital analysis (digital computer analysis of the pentothal EEG responses).
