We are continuing our study program of long acting fluphenazine enanthate (Squibb). Our experiences with the initial 80 subjects has encouraged us to continue as the treatment is acceptable to patients and appears to be as effective as oral phenothiazines.

Approximately half our patients are taking anti-parkinson medication and while we have recently obtained supplies from the hospital, I would be grateful if you could make available to us another shipment of 2,000 tablets, Kemadrin, 5 mg.
