Dear Henry,

We have recently completed two reports in our ongoing marijuana study program. Using NIMH marijuana we have elicited dose related changes in performance and in EEG. These observations must be repeated for confirmation, and we are awaiting some more concentrate THC to carry out these replications.

Incidentally, as I look back at our years of studies, I recall that we have spent much of the time waiting for the supplies, completing "official" forms, and answering committee inquiries. Perhaps, in your role on the Presidential Commission, you may do a service by inquiring into the governmental procedures for making "legal" and official supplies of marijuana, THC and hashish available for researchers.
