Enclosed is a more recent summary of our experiences with levomethadyl. We are impressed that should levomethadyl prove to be as effective as methadone, its general use may reduce the availability of illicit methadone. In this view, we are probably more optimistic than Jaffe and his co-workers, who recently reported their experiences with methadyl acetate in J.A.M.A.

As you may know, I am moving my laboratories to the State University of New York at Stony Brook, and will try to establish a treatment and study unit at Northport.
