I was most interested in your comments regarding the antidepressant effects of procyclidine. At the time that I undertook systematic studies of imipramine and chlorpromazine at Hillside Hospital, we did treat a small number of patients with procyclidine alone, in order to determine the effects on psychological tests, EEG and behavior. We did not have sufficient material for a determination of changes in psychological tasks, but the EEG data was summarized. A copy of that preliminary report is enclosed for your interest.

I look forward to discussing this with you at your convenience.
