In looking through my notes for loxapine, I find that it is manufactured by Lederle Laboratories (a division of American Cyanamid), Pearl River, New York. Unfortunately, I have no relationship with the research people there.

Enclosed are a few citations from the recent literature on loxapine. I checked my ECDEU notes and found that Itil gave a verbal report on loxapine and the EEG at the 1973 ECDEU meeting. You may wish to call him for his experience.

I have spoken to Holland, and they will ship additional OI-63. I have not yet heard from the FDA regarding the placebo. They have received my notification, a copy of which is enclosed for your files.

I am scheduled to go to Europe on April 1 and will be stopping at Oss. If it will be at all helpful, I could present a progress statement to Henk and, if there are any problems at that time, perhaps we can make adjustments in the protocol. I will call you a few days before my departure.
