Dear Dr. Lantin:

I am delighted that you had an opportunity to hear about the facilities in St. Louis from Dr. Margerison. I have taken the liberty to write to Dr. Paterson and Dr. Pereira regarding your application.

Before recommending an appointment, it would be necessary to complete the application form which was sent to you in an earlier communication. Upon receipt of this, and a small photograph, if possible, I should be able to complete the processing of this application.

The matter of religion is an irrelevant one.

In rereading two of your letters, I find a number of questions that may not have been answered. Psychiatric appointments at this facility are on a long-term, full-time basis. All psychiatrists are assigned to work with patient populations. In general, the work week is 48 hours, but this is modified to suit the needs of the program and the projects. There are excellent accommodations within ten minutes of the Institution, both for rent and for sale. As a physician, the salaries are such as to provide a most comfortable living. There are, in addition, a number of small perquisites which may amplify the salary or provide funds to attend the meetings of national organizations. A number of members of our staff have had the occasion already
