We missed you at the meeting on antagonists. The data was encouraging, and three issues were foci of further study:

- 1) A collaborative, multi-hospital evaluation of cyclazocine (add, if supplies are available, of naloxone).
- 2) Development of long-acting antagonist, with duration measured in months.
- 3) Preclinical pharmacology of new antagonists now available at Endo, Reckitt & Colman (represented by Lederle in U.S.), and at the University of Rochester.

A summary is enclosed, as I sent it to Philip Abelson of Science.

Your encouragement has been most supportive, and I trust you will continue.
