Q1. What's your age?

A1. Around 40.

Q2. What do you do the entire day?

A2. I do household work, I go to the farm

Q3. Who's in your household?

A3. 2 children, me and my husband.

Q4. Are the children studying?

A4. Yes, they are both studying in 10th and 12th grade.

Q5. Who makes the decision?

A5. We all make it together.

Q6. Do you want your children to go for higher education?

A6. Whatever they want to do, we will decide together.

Q7. What are the problems you are facing?

A7. Everything is a problem. (laughs) We don't have money, or water or job.

Q8. What are the problems in the farm?

A8. We can't grow anything on the farm, without water.

Q9. What do you do in monsoons?

A9. If there's a rain- we plant crops.

Q10. Last monsoon, did you grow anything?

A10. No we didn't.

Q11. Does anyone do manual labor in your family?

A11. 2 people.

Q12. For how long?

A12. We either get it for 5 days or a month. 10-20 days in a month.

Q13. How do you pay the fees of your children?

A13. They took a loan from the relatives.

Q14. How much loan do they have?

A14. Around 2-3 lakhs.

Q15. How do you pay the loan and the interest?

A15. All by labor work or we ask our relatives.

Q16. Do you ask the landlord or relatives?

A16. We take it from family members- my father or father in laws or husband's brother.

Q17. 2 years ago, there was a flood and before that, there was a drought. So what were the difficulties you faced?

A17. Farm was washed off. No one was there. We couldn't grow crops. Plantation was destroyed.

Q18. How long was the water on the fields?

A18. One to two months.

Q19. After that, did you plant anything?

A19. No because the land was destroyed.

Q20. Do you plant anything in the winter?

A20. Weed. That's it.
