Q1. Age?

A1. 24-year-old.

Q2. What work do you do?

A2. Farming

Q3. How many people in the house?

A3. 2 brothers, mother, father, and 2 daughters. One daughter is 4 years and other is 2 years old.

Q4. What do you do all day?

A4. I mostly stay at the farm.

Q5. Who makes the decision in the house?

A5. Mostly, my father or me and my brother.

Q6. Do you have to ask your father for everything related to the house?

A6. Yes, we do.

Q7. Do you give him the money you make?

A7. Yes, we give it my father and when we need it, we ask him.

Q8. Do you do any prayer at the farm?

A8. Yes. We break coconut first.

Q9. How long ago was Bhungroo installed?

A9. About 7 months ago.

Q10. How was your land before Bhungroo?

A10. It was completely dry.

Q11. How much land do you have?

A11. We have around 30 acres.

Q12. What kind of crop do you plant?

A12. Arenda, Jeera, and cotton.

Q13. Before Bhungroo, how many seasons did you plant?

A13. Only one, and now that we have Bhungroo, we do 3-4 seasons.

Q14. How much money do you make?

A14. Around 6-7 lakh per season.

Q15. How many animals do you have?

A15. 7 buffaloes and 3-4 goats. I use them for the milk.

Q16. Did you have water shortage before bhungroo?

A16. Yes, we had to walk 3 km to the next village to get water.

Q17. After Bhungroo, do you get more respect in the village?

A17. Yes. We didn't have any water before. I didn't have work and other people in the village too. Now everyone is able to use Bhungroo and they know I have money, so they all talk to me nicely. We didn't have water for the animals before but now we have at home.

Q18. Did you take any loans?

A18. Yes, we did. 4-5 lakhs.

Q19. How did you pay off the loan?

A19. Every season, I use some money to pay it off.

Q20. This season did you plant any crop?

A20. Yes, arenda

Q21. Did you have any problems in the house before?

A21. No, we didn't

Q22. Any water shortage?

A22. Yes, we had to go to another village to get water- for the house and for the farm land.

Q23. How did you use to fetch the water?

A23. On the bike.

Q24. When did you find out about Bhungroo?

A24. 2 years ago.

Q25. Who told you about it?

A25. From the villagers- they talked about it.

Q26. Were you scared when they were building Bhungroo?

A26. Yes. We put money into it, so we were scared that it might not work.

Q27. Are you part of any other organization or project similar to Bhungroo?

A27. No.

Q28. Do you use the milk at home, or you sell it?

A28. I sell it at the dairy.

Q29. Did your condition at the farming the land changed since Bhungroo was installed?

A29. Yes. We just had it installed 6-7 months ago but it is really good.

Q30. What plants you use to grow before Bhungroo?

A30. Mostly plants for the animals.

Q31. Which seasons use to farm before Bhungroo?

A31. Monsoons and summers.

Q32. Is there any change in your lifestyle?

A32. No, no major difference.

Q33. Did you buy any vehicles?

A33. Yes, I bought a scooter. I had it before too.

Q34. During the flood: what happened?

A34. For 2 months, there was water around the house and field.

Q35. Did you encounter any major loss?

A35. Yes.

Q36. Before you didn't have bhungroo, did you go to other villages for manual labor?

A36. Yes, I did.

Q37. Everyone in the house use to go to work?

A37. No, only 4 of us.

Q38. How much money did you make?

A38. 100 rupees a day

Q39. In one year, for how many months did you do manual work?

A39. For about 8 months.

Q40. Your wife also worked?

A40. Yes.

Q41. Did any of your family members participate in the elections?

A41. No.

Q42. Did you tell anyone else about Bhungroo?

A42. I told people in other villages.

Q43. Did you plant any trees after Bhungroo?

A43. When we got the water, we planted trees.

Q44. Did it benefit you?

A44. We had fruits for the children and also it provided shade under the trees at the fields.
