Q1. What is your age?

A1. I am 40-48 years old. I am not sure.

Q2. What do you do the entire day?

A2. I wake up, I clean the house, bathing, brushing, breakfast, going to work after that, than I come home and cook dinner, then I got out for a bit to have fun.

Q3. Who's in your household?

A3. 2 sons and their wives. 6 people in total.

Q4. Who makes the decision in your house?

A4. All of us come together to make the decision.

Q5. Do you have father-in-law or mother in law making decisions?

A5. Yes, but they live separate.

Q6. Do you impose decision in the house?

A6. I treat my daughter in laws like my daughters.

Q7. What is the biggest problem in farming and the work you are doing?

A7. Biggest problem is lack of water. If there is water, we go farm. Even though there is no water, we go on other people's farm to farm. Everyone's struggling because of that- plants, animals..(cattle).

Q8. How do you feed the cattle?

A8. We feed the cattle the weeds that grow at the fields. We buy the food for them sometimes, if there is no left over. For water, sometimes we use municipal water.

Q9. How far do you have to go to fetch water?

A9. ½ - 1 Km from the farm.

Q10. How many people are working in the manual labor?

A10. 2. My son and daughter in law.

Q11. Do you work from the main town? Outside the village?

A11. There is a lot of work in the city.

Q12. Does your daughter in law get the work?

A12. Not too much. Only a little.

Q13. How many days do you go to work? Annually?

A13. Half a year. 6-8 months

Q14. 2 years ago, there was a flood and before that, there was a drought. So what were the difficulties you faced?

A14. All the crops were destroyed in the fields. There was no money in the house and everyone was sad. Fertile soil on the top was destroyed. And then in the winter, they got the water from canals. But even there, we weren't getting water. It wasn't reaching us.

Q15. Do you want to try bhungroo?

A15. Yes of course.

Q16. Do you think it will be useful to you?

A16. Yes, we will definitely getting water from it.

Q17. Is the situation in terms of water getting worse or is it still the same?

A17. It's getting worse as the days go. Water is getting less and less.
