Q1. Do you have a say in your family decisions?

A1. I do have say in my decisions

Q2. Does your family help with chores?

A2. My family doesn't help with house chores

Q3. What do they do to help?

A3. If I am not in the house they will make cha (tea) for the guests, but I am at home, I will have to do everything.

Q4. Are you part of any women's organization?

A4. I am not in any women's organization

Q5. Do you work?

A5. I used to do a job before.

Q6. Where did you work?

A6. I used to work in dairy farm.

Q7. What do you do now?

A7. Either I go to work or my husband, because someone has to look for kids. I work for myself and he works for himself after the Bhungroo, I don't have to give my money to my father-in-law

Q8. How much land do you have?

A8. I have 5 acre land (whatever grows in it, will be my money). Mine and my brothers land are different

Q9. After getting water from Bhungroo, are there any changes in your farm?

A9. After bhungroo life is easier, before I had to go fill water

Q10. Was it helpful?

A10. Right now after the water facility, life is become easier. We get enough water for bath, our bucket is filled.

Q11. Do you have bathrooms installed?

A11. We don't need bathrooms, will think about it once we get electricity. We live here 4 months, and in *Unara* we go back

Q12. How much money do you earn?

A12. We earn 3500 a month after the bungaroo, we are currently 4 people in the house and the money is enough.

Q13. What do you grow in the farm?

A13. I have grown rundo in my farm because I don't have the right machinery.

Q14. Do you work in any other job- labor work?

A14. I don't do job anymore, I work in our own farm

Q15. Are your kids attending school?

A15. I am going to educate my kid, she will start next year once she turns 5.

Q16. Do they have to move around?

A16. They are not migrating anymore. Before, we use to migrate.

Q17. As a women, has Bhungroo been helping?

A17. Now, we have 7 buffalos- to feed them and arrange water for them before bhungroo we had to walk miles. But now, we can focus on only working in the field and don't have to walk so much. Now, I have more time to do my other work and help others.

Q18. Has bhungroo changed her reputation in the family?

A18. Yes, it makes my life easier. I am doing knitting class now. I spend more time on it now. I am going to start this as a small business- take work from other people around the village. It makes me feel proud because I can contribute to the family's income.
